As you are aware, Panchayat Sashaktikaran Purastans (PSP) and Rashtriya Guarav Gram Sabha Puraskars (RGGSP) have been destituted to encourage, appreciate and incentivize the Panchayats and Gram Sabhas for their outstanding performance in improvements of socio-economic structure of Panchayats. It is expected that these awards would strengthen MoPR's endeavor to deepen the process of decentralization. Number of PSPs for each tier of Panchayat in the State has been decided on the basis of pre-determined criteria. Similarly, RGGSFs are awarded to 20 best Gram Panchayats in the country where the Gram Sabhas have shown outstanding ৪.৭.15 performance. Best two/three nominations are invited from each State for this purpose.

During this year, it has been decided to reorient the PSPs to include performance of पंचायती राज विभिन्न।s in various thematic areas viz. sanitation, civic services (drinking water, street light, उत्तर प्रदेश शास् infra structure etc.), natural resource management, marginalized sections (women, SC/ST, disabled), social sector performance, disaster management, and innovation in revenue generation. One-third of the total PSP awards are proposed in the categories of thematic awards. While the General PSP awards will be evaluated on 100 points, the thematic awards will be evaluated on 120 points.

3. Separate criteria have been developed for the Panchayats who have done good work in the implementation of the MGNREGS activities. The nominations under this theme will be considered at the level of Gram Panchayats only.

4. Criteria have been developed for Gram Panchayats to capture the salient points of the proposed themes in consultation with experts and State representatives. The States may devise their own questionnaire for 20 marks for Block/District Panchayats for the thematic categories mentioned in Para 2 above on the lines of questionnaire for Gram Panchayats. The draft indicators are enclosed for perusal and suggestions, if any for additions to the criteria mentioned in the enclosed documents, so that the same can be considered for inclusion. The Panchayats may apply for General or Thematic award. (all/any) or both. Other points in respect of these awards are:

The nominations for the awards for 2014-15 will be invited online in a time bound manner with deadline of November 30, 2015 so that adequate time is available for verification by the national level monitors and transfer of incentives.

 The States may add questions at the end of the PSP questionnaire to capture the state specific parameters. The criteria for RGGSP will, however, remain fixed.

- The criteria for another Award (proposed to be given to one CBO per state) in the category "Individuals/CBOs, etc., taking voluntary actions to help and support panchayat/supplementing efforts of Panchayat, etc.", are being finalized. This award is for recognizing individuals/CBOs supporting Panchayats and does not involve monetary component. Suggestions, if any may also be given by September 15, 2015. Further details in this regard will be intimated soon.
- The Panchayats/Gram Sabha which have been awarded thrice in the past will be eligible for nomination only during FY 2017-18 (for the award period of 2016-17).
- The award under the theme "MGNREGS" will be for Gram Panchayats only. The award will be given by the MoRD on the recommendations of MoPR.
 - 5. The State Governments are requested to advise the officials concerned to initiate action for obtaining and forwarding nominations to MoPR online in the modified MIS which will be ready within next 15 days.

CUIDELINES FOR RASHTRIYA GAURAV GRAM SABHA PURASKAR

- 1. Name of the Award -RASHTRIYA GAURAV GRAM SABHA PURASKAR(RGGSP)
- 2. Period- Annual
- 3. Period of evaluation: From April to March of preceding year
- 4. Award: Upto Rs. 10 Lakh (Rupee Ten lakh to each Gram Panchayat) and a commemorative plaque.

5. Objective:

- 5.1 The Rashtriya Gaurav Gram Sabha Puraskar (National Award) was instituted by GOI in the year 2010 in order to incentivize, appreciate and encourage the Gram Panchayats of the country, for outstanding performance, through effective Gram Sabhas, especially in respect of improvements in the social and economic structure of the village.
- 5.2 The main objective of instituting this award is to strengthen the institution of Gram Sabha and to highlight it as the institution for decision and social audit. It is expected that this award would strengthen this Ministry's endeavor to deepen the process of decentralization. Gram Sabha is a vibrant forum for promoting planned economic and social development of the villages in a transparent way. Gram Sabha ensures direct participative democracy and offers equal opportunity to all citizens including the poor, the women and the marginalized to discuss, critically evaluate, various serious issues that affect the socio-economic development of the village.
- 5.3 Under this award, the Gram Panchayats are advised to prepare their own report based on the parameters laid down by GOI and forward it to State Committees. In the previous years this award has sensitized district administration about holding meaningful and vibrant Gram Sabhas and widening their scope of discussions.
- 5.4 As per the guidelines issued by GOI (Guidelines No. J-11011/80/2011-Media, dated 8th December, 2011). four (4) Gram Sabhas are mandatory, which should be fixed at least once a quarter on specified days. GP may be left free to call for additional meetings of Gram Sabhas and special Gram Sabhas to address important social issues by giving adequate and advance notice and GP may also call for emergency meetings of Gram Sabhas as per notified rules.
- 6. These nominations must reach the MoPR as per timeline declared by MoPR.

7. Selection committee at District level.

- District Collector Chairman
- CEO, Zilla Parishad Member Convenor
- Chief District Medical Officer- Member
- District Education Officer Member
- Two District level officers in charge of ICDS programme and Agriculture - Members
- Two experts chosen by the Collector Members

8. Selection committee at State level:

- Secretary in charge of Panchayati Raj Chairperson
- Secretary in charge of Health and family welfare Member
- Secretary in charge of Primary Education Member
- Secretary, Women and Child Development Member
- Secretary, Agriculture Member
- Two experts chosen by the Chairperson.

9. Selection Committees at National levels:

MoPR will consider the proposals received from the States and recommend the grant of award to Best Gram Sabhas from each State.

10. Utilization of Award amount by the Gram Panchayat:

(i) Utilization of Award amount by the Gram Panchayat:

The Award money will be utilized by the Gram Panchayat for public purposes such as holding of Gram Sabha/Ward Sabha/ Mahila Sabha meetings, facilitation for livelihood support including agriculture and allied activities, augmentation of civic services like primary education, primary health care, safe drinking water, sanitation, public utilises; provision of rural infrastructure. These funds may be utilised for bridging the gap in case of projects for which funds have been received from the Central and State Governments. However, these funds may be spent for specific projects which will highlight for fact that the funds were received under Rashtriya Gauray Gram Sabha Award.

(ii) Utilization Certificate

The State concerned would arrange to furnish a utilization certificate in prescribed GFR 19-A, immediately on utilization of the prize amount or at the end of the financial year succeeding the year to which the award amount pertains. This will be accompanied by statement depicting itemized expenditure.

11. Number of GPs/GS to be awarded and amount of incentive:

20 RGGS award will be given to the best Gram Parchayats and the prize money will be Rs. 10 lakh each (Rupees Ten lakh only). However MoPR may announce for special award of RGGS from time to time.

12. Short Listing of Best Gram Sabhas by State Committee

- i. RGGSP will be given to the Gram Panchavats. The Sarpanch/Sabhapati/Village Head/ Panchayat President or any representative nominated by the Sarpanch /Sabhapati/Village Head / Panchayat President will receive this award on (National Panchayati Raj Day, at Delhi).
- The performance of Gram Panchayat during the period 2014-15 would be evaluated for award in 2016. The evaluation period would be counted from 1st April, 2014 to 31st March, 2015.
- iii. Each district will send one best performing Grav Sabha to the State Government for consideration of the State level Selection Committee. The State level Selection Committees will select best two/three Gram Sabhas and forward the same along with necessary documents proof, to MoPR as per the timeline declared by MoPR.
- iv. The national level Selection Committee constituted by the MoPR will scrutinize the proposals received from States and recommend best Gram Sabha(s) from each State to the Government for award of RGGSP.

13. Field verification.

- (i) MoPR will verify through independent agencies the information presented by the Gram Panchayats for nomination of the award on the prescribed format, in each State, if necessary.
- (ii) Guidelines to be followed by identified independent agencies would be issued by MoPR.
- (iii) On the basis of this verification, the Gram Panchay its suggested by the State will be accepted as the nominees for Rashtriya Gaurav Gram Sabha Puraskaar" except if:

- (i) information given by GP is found to be incorrect by the Field Visit Team.
- (ii) The indicators, questionnaire and marking scheme of the GP/State Committee is not found to be correct or incomplete. In either case, funds earmarked for such PRIs would be evenly distributed among other PRIs/elected councils of same States.
- (iii) The decision of the Government of India for award of Rashtriya Gaurav Gram Sabha Puraskaar to Gram Panchayat(s) will be final.

14. Submission of report by the State on the utilization of cash award.
